PRIZES FOR BEST PAPERS

There are a number of prizes for the best papers submitted at the Indian History Congress session in particular sections or fields of history by members who are not above the age of 45 years, and the last date for the receipt of papers submitted for the prize is 30th November, 2022. Proof of age (e.g., copy of Aadhaar Card or PAN Card or Passport page or High School Certificate) is required to be attached to the papers submitted. Please note, however, that there is no age-bar for Prize No. 8 below:

1. **Professor Vijay Kumar Thakur Memorial Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted for Section I (Ancient India).
2. **Professor J.S. Grewal Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted for Section II (Medieval India).
3. **Professor Partha Sarathi Gupta Memorial Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted for Section III (Modern India) and Section IV (Countries other than India).
4. **Professor J. C. Jha Memorial Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted for Section III (Modern India) and Section IV (Countries other than India).
5. **Professor Sudhir Ranjan Das Memorial Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted for Section V (Archaeology).
6. **Professor Papiya Ghosh Memorial Prize** (Rs. 15,000) for the best paper submitted for Section VI (Contemporary India)
7. **Professor B. B. Chaudhuri Prize** (Rs. 10,000) for the best paper submitted on Economic and Social History of India (Ancient, Medieval and Modern).
8. **Dr. I.G. Khan Memorial Prize** (Rs. 15,000) for the best paper submitted on History of Science and Technology (No age bar).
9. **Dr Nasreen Ahmad Memorial Prize** (Rs. 7,500) for the best paper on Gender History.

ADVICE FOR MEMBERS
SUBMITTING PAPERS FOR PRIZES

The Indian History Congress has now established a number of prizes that have been endowed with a view to encouraging younger scholars to publish the fruits of their research in a proper manner. They are therefore strongly urged to read our notices for prizes (one is included in this booklet) and submit their papers by meeting the prescribed requirements.

Our judges for the Prize Papers have been making several observations and suggestions, and largely on this basis, the following points are being brought to the attention of scholars wishing to submit papers for prizes

1. The theme chosen should *not* be one that has been done over and over again already by scholars, and there is nothing or little new to be added. Ordinarily, the paper should be based on the author's own research from primary sources, so that there is some distinct addition to historical knowledge. Merely reproducing other people's research in one's own words should be avoided. Polemical essays are not excluded but they should be backed by substantive reading. Earlier work in the field must always be acknowledged.

2. The language should be concise, and over-elaboration and inclusion of matter irrelevant to the main thrust and argument should be avoided. Strange or novel terminology with senses that are vague or ambiguous needs to be pruned.

3. A judge has especially warned against incautious use of material from the internet which is often unverified and unauthoritative. The use of wikipedia, acknowledged or not, is particularly to be avoided.

4. Judges have often expressed dissatisfaction with the way references are furnished. Either the classical system (generally in use in History) or the scientific system (often met with in Archaeology) should be followed, but not both. In any case, full publication details (full name of author, title of work, place and year of publication) should be provided along with the page or pages referred to. Citations should never be lifted from other books or papers. If a source that is cited in some other work, is not available to the author of the paper, the work where that citation occurs should also be cited. (e.g. 'X as cited in Y', where Y is available but X is not).

5. Maps, photographs and diagrams may be included, but only if directly relevant to the theme of the paper.

6. Plagiarism of any kind is inexcusable. If any portion of any other author's text is used it should be placed within inverted commas with due acknowledgement or reference provided for it. A paper is liable to be rejected out of hand if such unacknowledged use of someone else's text is detected.

7. English spellings should be according to the British usage (thus 'labour', not 'labor'; 'traveller', not 'traveler'). Authors are urged to use dictionaries freely for checking their spellings.

GENERAL PRESIDENT: PROFESSOR KESAVAN VELUTHAT

Professor Kesavan Veluthat is a former Professor in the Department of History from the Delhi University (2009-2016) and Chairman of the Department of History, Mangalore University. He has been a visiting professor at Ecole Pratique des Hautes Etudes, Paris; Maison des Sciences de l'Homme, Paris as well as Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi and Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. In 2008 he completed a major research project funded by the Ford Foundation known as the, "Historical Atlas of South India". He has given lectures as well as presented papers in conferences across the country, as well as internationally in Columbia University, New York, University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia and in Germany in the Universities of Kiel, Erfurt, Freiburg and Tubingen. He has been associated with the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in assessing universities and colleges in India. Apart from being associated with the Indian History Congress, he has also chaired sessions at the Andhra Pradesh and the Punjab History Congress.

His major works include, *Brahman Settlements in Kerala: Historical Studies*, (Kozhikode, Sandhya Publications, 1978; revised and enlarged edition, Cosmo Books, Thrissur, 2013); *The Political Structure of Early Medieval South India*, (New Delhi, Orient Longman, 1993; second revised edition, New Delhi, Orient Blackswan, 2012); *Kerala Through the Ages*, (Thiruvananthapuram, Department of Public Relations, Government of Kerala, 1976) with M. G. S. Narayanan, et al. He also has edited several volumes including, *Kerala State and Society in Pre-modern South India*, ed., with R. Champakalakshmi and T. R. Venugopalan (Cosmo Books, Thrissur, 2002); *The Early Medieval in South India*, Oxford University Press, (New Delhi, 2009; first paperback edition, 2010; sixth edition, 2014); *Irreverent History: Essays for M. G. S. Narayanan*, ed., with Donald R. Davis, Primus Books, Delhi, 2014. He has also authored several books in Malyalam which deal with history and literature in Malyalam, and has edited a Latin-Malyalam dictionary volume.

Professor Ishrat Alam is the former chairperson and co-ordinator at the Centre of Advanced Study in the Department of History, Aligarh Muslim University. He is an experienced professor with a record of working in the higher education and curriculum development. He has been a recipient of the Netherlands Government Reciprocal Fellowship. He has worked as a managing Editor for the Indian Historical Review on behalf of the Indian Council of Historical Research. Pai has been member of many academic boards, including currently the Advisory Committee of the Bharti Institute of Public Policy, Mohali, and part of ISB Hyderabad. Widely travelled, she has organized and attended various National and International Seminars and Conferences. Well known for research on various aspects of Indian Politics, particularly on the state of Uttar Pradesh, she has authored a number of books and papers in reputed national and international journals. Her latest book *Everyday Communalism: Riots in Contemporary Uttar Pradesh* (co-authored with Sajjan Kumar) has been described as an insightful study on communalism today, ethnographically rich and which unfolds the process of everyday communalism in the context of the present political economy. She is also well known for her articles in leading national newspapers such as The Indian Express, The Economic Times and websites such as thewire.in. on contemporary politics and public policy.
